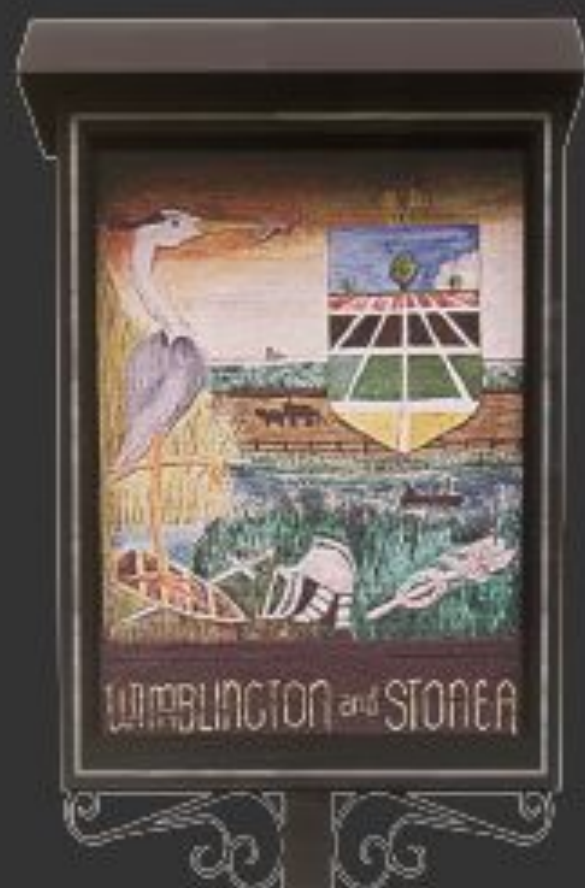

Regulation 14, a six week pre-submission consultation.

This will be from 28th October 2024 – 9th December 2024.

This is the last opportunity that residents and local businesses will have to comment on the Neighbourhood Plan before it is submitted to Fenland District Council to arrange an independent examination.

All responses received by 2359hrs on the 9th December 2024 will be considered by the Parish council and Steering Group and may be utilised to amend the Draft Neighbourhood Plan. A Consultation Statement, including a summary of all comments received, will be made available on our website along with the amended Neighbourhood Plan in due course.

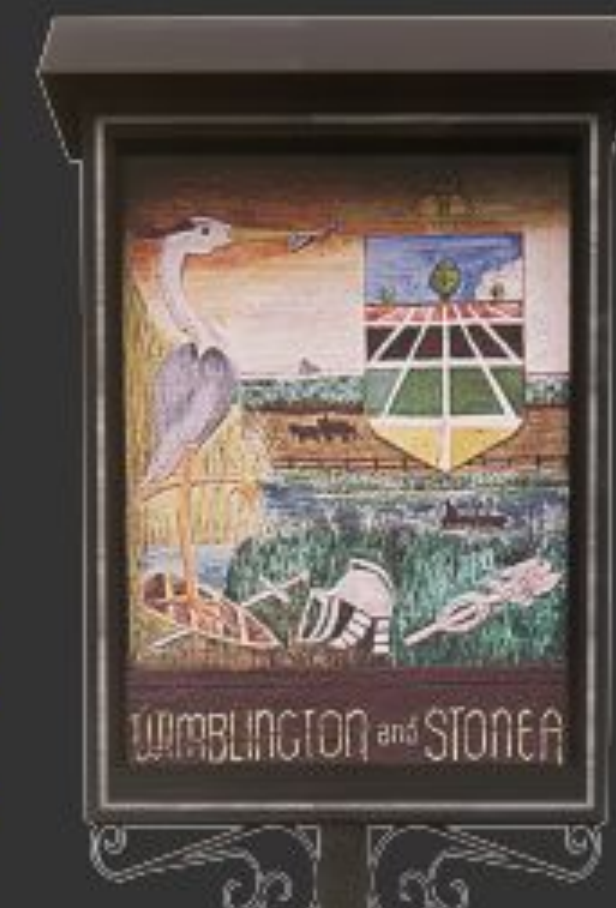
